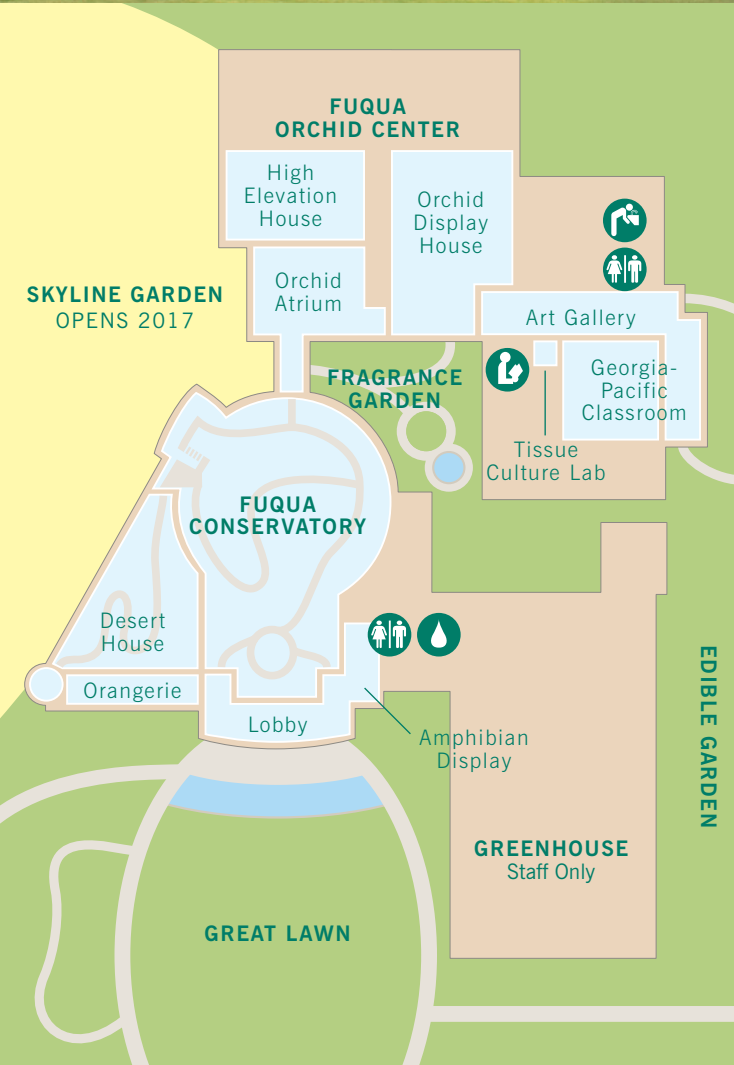

Plant collections feature perennials, roses, herbs, conifers, carnivorous plant bogs, wildflowers, hardy tropicals, woodland gardens and gorgeous annual displays.

Fuqua Conservatory & Orchid Center

Explore rare tropical and desert plants from around the world and the largest orchid center in the United States. The Conservation Center houses a native plant restoration program, tissue culture lab and amphibian program.

Kendeda Canopy Walk

Take in breathtaking views from the tree canopy of Storza Woods on a graceful 600-foot-long suspension walkway up to 40 feet in the air.

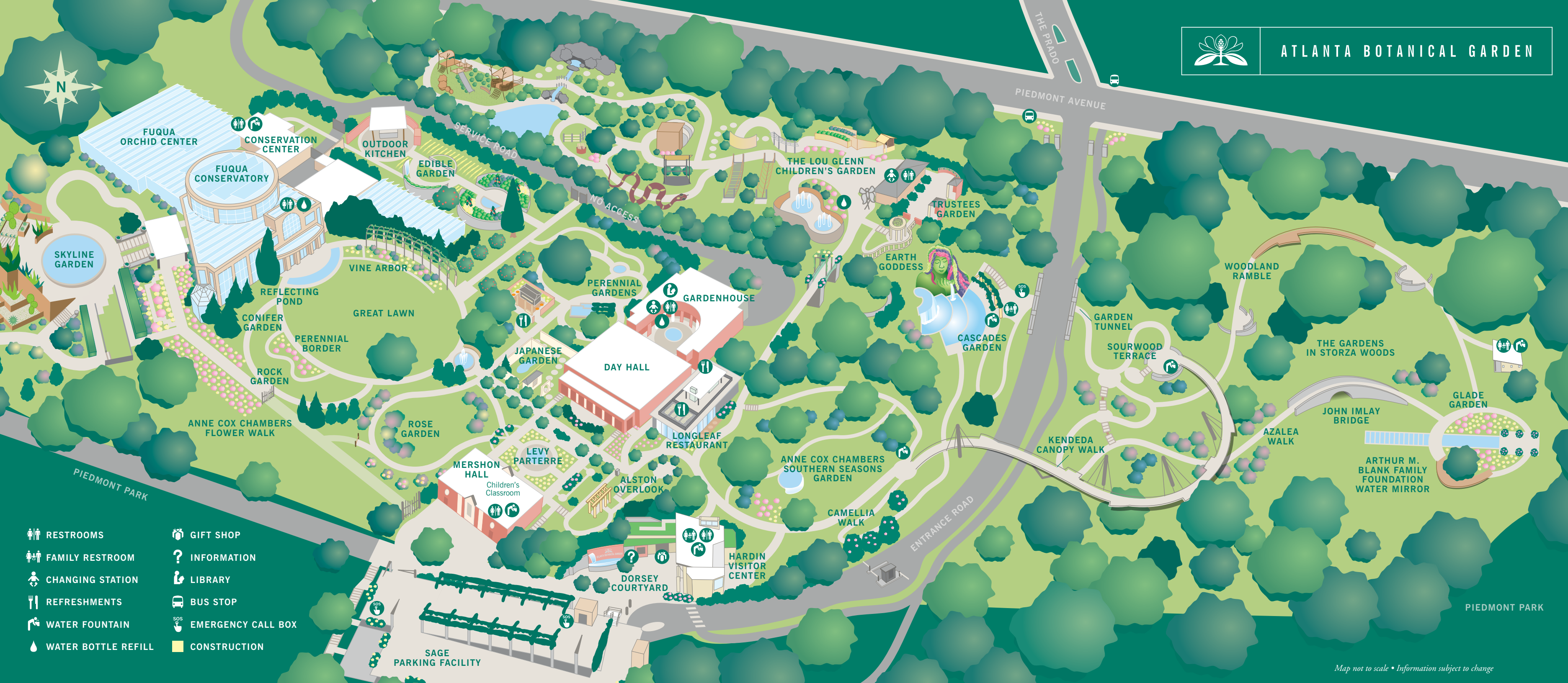
garden map
