

CONSERVING IMPERILED PLANTS

Scientific exploration is central to the Garden's mission as we work to protect rare and endangered plants in fragile ecosystems throughout the Southeast and beyond. Our dynamic Conservation & Research Team includes three PhD researchers and 22 conservation scientists who collaborate closely with each other and with our partner organizations. Together they blend rigorous field study and habitat restoration with state-of-the-art molecular research and development of the safeguarding collections maintained by the Garden.

EDUCATING ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDS

The Garden offers a wide range of STEM enrichment activities that elevate science curricula in K-12 classrooms. Aligned with statewide grade-level learning standards, our Children's Education Initiative (CEI) primarily serves students at under-resourced Title I schools, with all program costs and admission fees waived. The Garden's education programs truly benefit students of all ages, from welcoming local kindergarteners on special Kinder in the Garden visits to introducing high schoolers to botanical careers through intensive internships. In addition, daily drop-in family activities, free with admission, inspire young children to discover the wonders of our natural world.

ENGAGING COMMUNITY

Diversifying audiences and expanding outreach are important strategic goals both inside and outside the Garden gates. Our innovative community access program, Explore, offers deeply discounted Garden memberships to teachers, nurses, sanitation workers, and other vital service providers who work for one of four partners: Atlanta Public Schools, City of Atlanta, Grady Health System, and MARTA. The Garden also helps to address local food insecurity through our flagship urban agriculture program, Plant. Eat. Repeat., which gives hands-on assistance to community gardens, refugee communities, and other groups working in food deserts to expand access to fresh, healthy produce.

ENHANCING QUALITY OF LIFE

As one of the top destinations in our region, the Garden enriches the cultural landscape with vibrant programming drawing more than 750,000 visitors annually. Every season presents new opportunities to enjoy ever-evolving horticultural displays, blockbuster exhibitions of outdoor sculpture, family-friendly festivals, extended evening hours, and so much more. Atlanta's temperate climate ensures that there is always something blooming—and whenever members and guests visit throughout the year, they are certain to feel recharged and rejuvenated, surrounded by the beauty of nature.
