- 14" x 17" smooth surface Bristol Board Pad (preferred size) (11" x 14" okay)
- 11" x 14" Canson Brand tracing paper pad (25 lb/50 sheets)
- **Two HB graphite Pencils** Staedtler brand recommended These pencils are for preliminary drawings (with pink peal and white plastic eraser tips.)
- Manual pencil sharpener- Brass or metal, keep in zip lock bag
- Pink Pearl eraser, Grey kneaded eraser, white plastic eraser
- 3/4" white artists tape (1/2" okay)
- Two "Le Pens" or Sharpie Fine Point Marker (Black)
- Set of fine line pens: Micron (or equivalent brand) 005 Extra Fine 01 Fine 03 Medium 05 Heavy
- **Camera** for photo documentation (cell phone camera)
- **One sheet medium grade sandpaper** cut into 8 pieces To be used to clean your pink pearl and white plastic erasers.
- Textbook: How to Draw Plants; The Techiniques of Botanical Illustration by Keith West (Timber Press) ISBN 0-88192-350-8
- 12" Metal Ruler- with cork backing to lift edge "up" from paper surface
- Gooseneck drawing lamp + extension cord (For use at home. Lamps provided in the classroom.)
- White Styrofoam board
 - ¼" thick 20"x30" white Styrofoam board Instructor will assist you in creating a "stage."
