Intro to Drawing in Black and White Materials List

Basic B+W Materials (Long Detailed List):

1. 14" x 17" All-purpose drawing pad

(50 sheets/spiral binding acid free, not recycled, not textured or medium tooth.)

Recommended brands: Canson, Strathmore, etc.

OR

14"x17" Bristol Board Pad

(20 Sheets, glued binding, acid free, heavy weight, smooth surface)

2. Set of five basics drawing pencils: 6B, 4B, 2B, *B, HB, 2H *(Purchase B Separately)

Recommended brands: Faber Castell, Derwent, Prismacolor

Optional Pencils: Carpenter's pencil (2B)/Ebony Jet Black Extra Smooth

3. **Fine Line Black Pen**: Le Pen, 03 Staedler, 03 Micron, etc. Purchase one or two pens .03 is a medium size pen point.

Optional Pens: Purchase set of pens (range of pen point sizes)

4. Charcoal Pencil: Extra Soft/Soft

Optional: (Medium/Hard)

General is a good brand for charcoal pencils.

- 5. **#3 Stump Blender** (rolled grey paper into long cylinder about the size of a pencil at both ends it is used to spread charcoal on the paper.)
- 6. Sandpaper: one sheet, medium grade from Home Depot or Ace.
- 7. Manual Pencil Sharpener

Double endings, brass or metal, keep in zip lock to contain the shavings. No electric sharpeners please.

- 8. **Erasers:** Pink Pearl, White Plastic Eraser (Magic Rub)/Kneaded Eraser (grey); Also, Pink Pearl and white plastic eraser TIPS to be used at the top of your drawing pencils.
- 9. **Magnifying glass**, magnification glasses (reading glasses)
- 10. Small lightweight flashlight
- 11. Lightweight **plastic box** (w/lid) for art materials
- 12. Clear Plastic Ruler 1" wide with red rule lines $\frac{1}{16}$ " | $\frac{1}{8}$ " | $\frac{1}{4}$ " | $\frac{1}{2}$ " | etc.
- 13. 14" x 17" plastic bag with handles to carry all art supplies
- 14. Clear 8"x10" (vertical) plexi picture holder with "foot"
- 15. Small **digital camera** for photo documentation

Specific Materials for Intro to Drawing in Black and White

- 3-4 Simple Black and White Photographs/magazine images of natural objects (simple compositions/good range of values: black to white with graduating grey tones. (Class 1 &2)
- Collection of Natural Objects (in box with lid): rocks, stones, variety of large and small seashells, feathers, sticks, bark, pressed leaves, nuts, seeds, insects; look for unusual items that have "character"
