

Introduction to Drawing in Colored Pencil Materials List

1. 14" X 17" Bristol board pad

20 sheets, glued binding, acid free, heavy weight, smooth surface – not vellum or textured

2. Set of Prismacolor Pencils (set of 48 is recommended)

Prismacolor is a soft, buttery wax pencil line that is excellent for beginning student of colored pencil.

3. Manual pencil sharpener

With double openings: brass or silver metal. Keep in Ziploc clear back to contain shavings. Please have a separate sharpener for colored pencils.

4. Erasers: Pink Pearl Eraser, White Plastic (Magic Rub), Grey Kneaded Erasers, Pink Pearl and White Plastic Eraser Tips

Easer tips can be used at the top of your drawing pencils.

5. (2) HB graphite pencils

These pencils are for preliminary drawings (with pink peal and white plastic eraser tips.)

6. (1) sheet medium grade sandpaper

To be used to clean your pink pearl and white plastic erasers.

7. Small pair of scissors

8. Rubber bands (to bundle "working pencils")

9. Clear plastic ruler 1" wide

The ruler should have red rule lines: 1/8", 1/4", 1/2", 3/4", and 1"

10. Small Digital Camera

To photo document

11. Clear 8"x10" plexi (vertical) picture holder with "foot"

12. White Artist's Tape (optional)

13. Magnifying glass (optional)

14. Small flashlight (optional)

15. 14" X 17" vinyl carrying bag (optional)

To carry all drawing materials
