## **Drawing Class Materials List**

Class: Drawing Orchids in Black & White

- 1. Bring Basic Black and White Drawing Materials:
  - 14" x 17" Bristol Board Pad smooth/ not vellum preferred
  - Set of five basic drawing pencils: 6B, 4B, 2B, HB, 2H (+B)
  - 1-2 Fine line black pen: Le Pen, .03 Staedler or .03 Micron
  - (General) Charcoal Pencil: Extra Soft, Soft (required) optional: Medium, Hard
  - #3 Stump Blender (grey paper cylinder use with charcoal)
  - One sheet medium grade sandpaper cut into 8 pieces
  - Manual pencil sharpener with 2 openings: brass or silver metal (keep in clear snack Ziploc bag)
  - Small pair scissors
  - Erasers: Pink Pearl Eraser, White Plastic (Magic Rub), Grey Kneaded, Eraser Tips (Pink Pearl and white plastic)
  - and white plastic)
  - Magnifying Glass
  - 8" X 10" Clear, Vertical Plexi-Glass frame with foot for problem solving
  - Small, lightweight flashlight
  - Lightweight plastic box with handle for carrying art materials
  - Clear Plastic Ruler 1" wide with red rule lines at 1/8th inch increments
  - 14" x 17" heavy vinyl carrying bag with handle to carry drawing pads and other materials
  - Camera for photo documentation (cell phone camera)
- 2. 20" X 30" (17" X 28") White Styrofoam Board 3/16"  $\frac{1}{4}$ " thick This will be used to make your "still life stage" (Instructor will assist you.)

## 3. An Orchid

Select an orchid with a pattern and deeper colors. Please avoid white or pale colors. (18" tall from the bottom of the pot to top/blooms at eyelevel when you are sitting at table. Please do not bring an orchid that is too tall. Suggested orchids: Phalaenopsis (moth orchids) or Paphiopedilum (lady slipper orchids)

- 4. White Artist's Tape- 1/2" or 3/4"
- 5. 11" x 14" Canson Exceptionally Transparent Tracing Paper pad (for problem solving)
